Accommodation and services

We offer a range of accommodation options and professional services to suit residents in all stages of care. Talk to our staff about the options that best suit your needs and inspect our facility for yourself.

- ▶ Accommodation for up to 120 residents in a modern facility just 10 minutes from the Adelaide city centre.
- ▶ A variety of accommodation is available to choose from including single and shared rooms and facilities.
- ▶ A secure Memory Support Unit providing clinical and lifestyle staff dedicated to caring for people with dementia.
- ▶ 24 hour on-site access to registered and enrolled nurses for immediate care and specialised nursing treatments.
- ▶ Full-time occupational therapist providing personalised exercise programs to assist residents to remain active and independent.
- ▶ A regular visiting dentist, dietician and speech pathologist with personal consultations and appointments available.
- ▶ Food is cooked on-site and is culturally specific for residents.
- ▶ There is on average 30 activities a month to entertain residents including Greek bands.
- ▶ Men can enjoy daily Cafeneio, play cards and backgammon—a good opportunity to sit and discuss politics
- ▶ A Church is located on site holding weekly services. Saint days and name days are acknowledged and celebrated.
